Welcome! and thank you for registering your child

✠ Monday, July 10th, 8:45 a.m. Check-in/1st Day of Camp

Arrive with your child, verify which group your child will be in at the registration tables, and please come into the church WITH your child to meet their Group Leader.

✠ Monday-Friday Routine:

- Full day campers arrive each day at 9:00 a.m. and are to be picked up at 2:30 p.m. by their designated color-coded area in front of the church.
- Please notify the Group Leader when you take your child. For your child's safety we ask that you sign your child in and out each day!
- Preschoolers and $\frac{1}{2}$ day Kindergarten children will be picked up at 11:30 a.m. in the Lower Parking Area behind the church.
- Lunch: Full day K-6th grade campers need to bring a lunch and a drink every day.
- Please include any person who will be picking up your child on the registration form.
- If your child needs to leave camp for another activity, we would appreciate a written note given to us when they arrive in the morning. They need to be signed out with an adult supervisor.
- If you are planning to allow your child to walk home, we will need a signed note from a parent with a contact number.
- PLEASE: NO flip flop shoes! Send children in toed shoes or sandals to prevent injuries outside.
- PLEASE: NO CELL PHONES. If there is an emergency, you can reach us at 465-0779.
- Our service project for the week will be **LUTHERAN SOCIAL SERVICES MISSION PROJECT 2017.** We will be collecting items that will support families they provide for by helping them with start of school supplies as well as some items used in their homes. A list of needs will be handed out during the week.

✠ Friday, July 14th - Camp will end at 11:30. No lunches are needed on this day.

For the safety of your children, please drop them off no sooner than 8:50 a.m. and arrange to have them picked up no later than 2:45 p.m. as we are unable to provide supervision. If an emergency arises, please call the office to relay a message. Thank you for helping us to keep your children safe.
